

U.S.S. WEST POINT Ship's Dance

1. Hotel Astor, October 20, 1942. Entrance to Ballroom at 206 West 45th Street, New York City.
2. Essentially informal dress.
3. Corsages will not be furnished.
4. Favors in form of souvenir pins will be furnished for each lady.
5. Music begins at 2100 and lasts until 0200. Ballroom opens at 2000.
6. Music by two bands playing continuously. Each orchestra will change every 20 minutes.
7. Celebrities from different night clubs will be invited, and will provide entertainment from 0010 to 0030.
8. Dinner will be served at 2330.
9. Tips for waiters serving dinner will be paid for by the ship.
10. All drinks can be purchased at each individual table at the man's own expense throughout the evening. Usual tipping will be expected when drinks are served.
11. No liquor will be brought to the dance by individuals.
12. No guests other than official guests will be allowed except by special permission from the Dance Committee.
13. Lady partners will be furnished for men who can not bring their own girl friends.
14. Men may come as stags if they prefer.
15. Receiving line will be formed from 2230 to 2300.
